Charging e-bikes and e-scooters safely



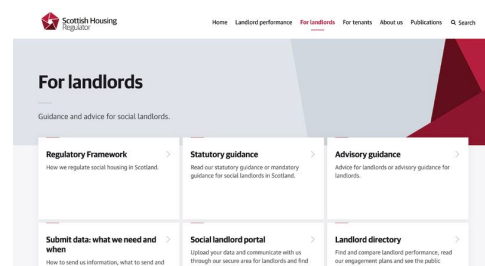
Avoid charging in exit routes like hallways or stairwells to ensure clear escape paths in the event of a fire. Opt for enclosed spaces like detached garages, sheds, or designated charging areas in high-rise flats. Prioritise safety and prevent potential hazards.

The Scottish Housing Regulator (SHR) has sent out an update which includes, amongst other things, their three year Strategy and work plans for 2024/25, updated factsheets and advisory guidance, their programme of annual assurance visits to social landlords, their report on gender equality on their Board and advice for landlords on preparing their Annual Assurance Statements.
